General Rules

1. All tractors must weigh with driver (200 lb. grace).
2. No double entry of tractors is same class.
3. No first pull option.
4. Tractors that need to be in the improved turbo class is the official's discretion (stock pump and turbo).
5. Hot Farm Class – Turbos must be 3x4 or less.
6. Super/Pro Class – Turbos must be 3x4 or larger and can run multiple turbos.
7. Gears may be shifted—machine must not stop forward motion.
8. Only one pull allowed each contestant unless a tie is declared.
9. Pulls within 2 inches will be considered a tie.
10. Factory turbo in all Farm Stock classes. Judge will decide if tractor is eligible.
11. Minors must have a written permission by parents/guardian in order to pull.
12. No weight frame or weight can be extended 24" beyond the front of the tractor in stock class and no hitch shall be closer than 18" to the center of the rear axle.
13. Drawbar height maximum will be 20" and a secure clevis and a 3" hole.
14. All pulls are made from drawbar. All pullers must furnish clevis fastened to the drawbar with 3/4" or larger bolt and nut or safety pin.
15. Loss of any weight or any part of the tractor or driver during pull will be grounds for disqualification.
16. Only qualified drivers will be allowed to drive the tractor in the pit area. Only puller allowed on tractor just before, during and right after the pull is completed and until tractor is parked. No consumption of intoxicating substances in the track area before or during time puller makes their pull. Operator must remain seated and drive in a safe manner.
17. All pullers must start with a tight chain and contestants will be allowed two consecutive attempts and 75' to start the sled.
18. The Buffalo County Agricultural Fair Association, Inc. or the committee will not be responsible for any mechanical or physical damages to machine or operator.
19. All tractors in the improve turbo class must have a working kill switch and wheelie bars.
20. All stock tractors must have working PTO.
21. No cut tires in stock classes.
22. All tractors allowed two hooks only.
23. All rules apply to trucks as well!
24. Any tractor is eligible to run in Open Class.
25. **8500# Stock Diesel Truck (stock turbo)** – No hanging weight out front; weight can be added in the bed of the truck; ladder bars and suspension stops are okay; 26" drawbar height.
26. **8500# Street Outlaw Diesel Truck** – Must be street legal truck; no welded or solid rear suspension; hanging front wight is okay; water methanol and nitrous are okay; add-on duals are okay; no turbo limits; no air to water intercoolers; must wear helmet; 26" drawbar height.
27. **8000# Open Truck** – Must have safety equipment; must wear a helmet; any fuel types (diesel, gas, alcohol).
